

Wildlife Damage Documentation

As a research project, in the fall of 2017 SAIRS documented elk damage in a standing crop of Canola. Using an eBee fixed wing agricultural drone, the crop and wildlife damage were documented from the air. The resulting flight images were stitched together into one large map of the field. Using integrated post processing tools, animal trails, beds, and feeding areas were identified and quantified. A final acre loss on the field was easily established.

Going forward, SAIRS will continue expand knowledge and experience in this service.
